lifelong skills and techniques that you can learn and practice to keep each other safe. The training will show you how to respond, rather than react. Certified ICPJ facilitators will teach you the basic tactics you can use to deescalate and/or redirect racial threats and harassment through non-violent methods and strategies. Cost: \$0-30

CLARA Pilot Training— Making Peace with our Words

How do we speak our truth without harming or ending a relationship? CLARA is a method for speaking and listening with an open heart. It stands for Calm and Center, Listen, Affirm, Respond and Add. It's been used by people around the world to keep the lines of communication open even when people are on opposite sides of an issue. Although the steps are simple, using them can have a profound impact, helping us treat others with respect and caring, rather than anger and dismissal. This training will give you a chance to practice and get comfortable with the steps of this process. Cost: \$10

Assertive, active nonviolence has been proven effective in conflict zone areas for decades. Meta Peace Team (MPT) and ICPJ are partnering to offer this training. You will learn specific skills & tools that are useful both in conflict intervention situations and in daily life (such as Active Listening, Personal Power-messages, and the CLARA technique). You will be introduced to tools for group work (Affinity teams and consensus decision making) and to the concept of "peace teams" or third-party nonviolent intervention (TPNI) and its scope of possibilities. *(Includes lunch)*
